Dear Secretary Walsh:

It is my understanding that you have been offered the position of executive director of the National Hockley League Players Association (NHLPA) and that you will soon resign as Secretary of Labor. As you prepare to leave federal employment, I remind you that your office—whether it be in Washington, D.C., or in Boston—may contain materials that are relevant to requests made by the Committee on Education and the Workforce.

In particular, these materials may be critical in providing answers to the Committee's inquiries related to ethics advice you received about your participation in labor-management activities and about your search for employment outside of the federal government.<sup>3</sup> They may also be critical in providing answers to the Committee's inquiries related to your tenure as Vice-Chairman of the White House Task Force on Worker Organizing and Empowerment, your personal attendance at its meetings, and your communications with the private-sector parties involved with its recommendations to the President and implementation of those recommendations.<sup>4</sup> In addition, the Committee has an interest in any materials pertaining to your decision-making regarding the promulgation of Department of Labor (DOL) regulations and your duties and decision-making
